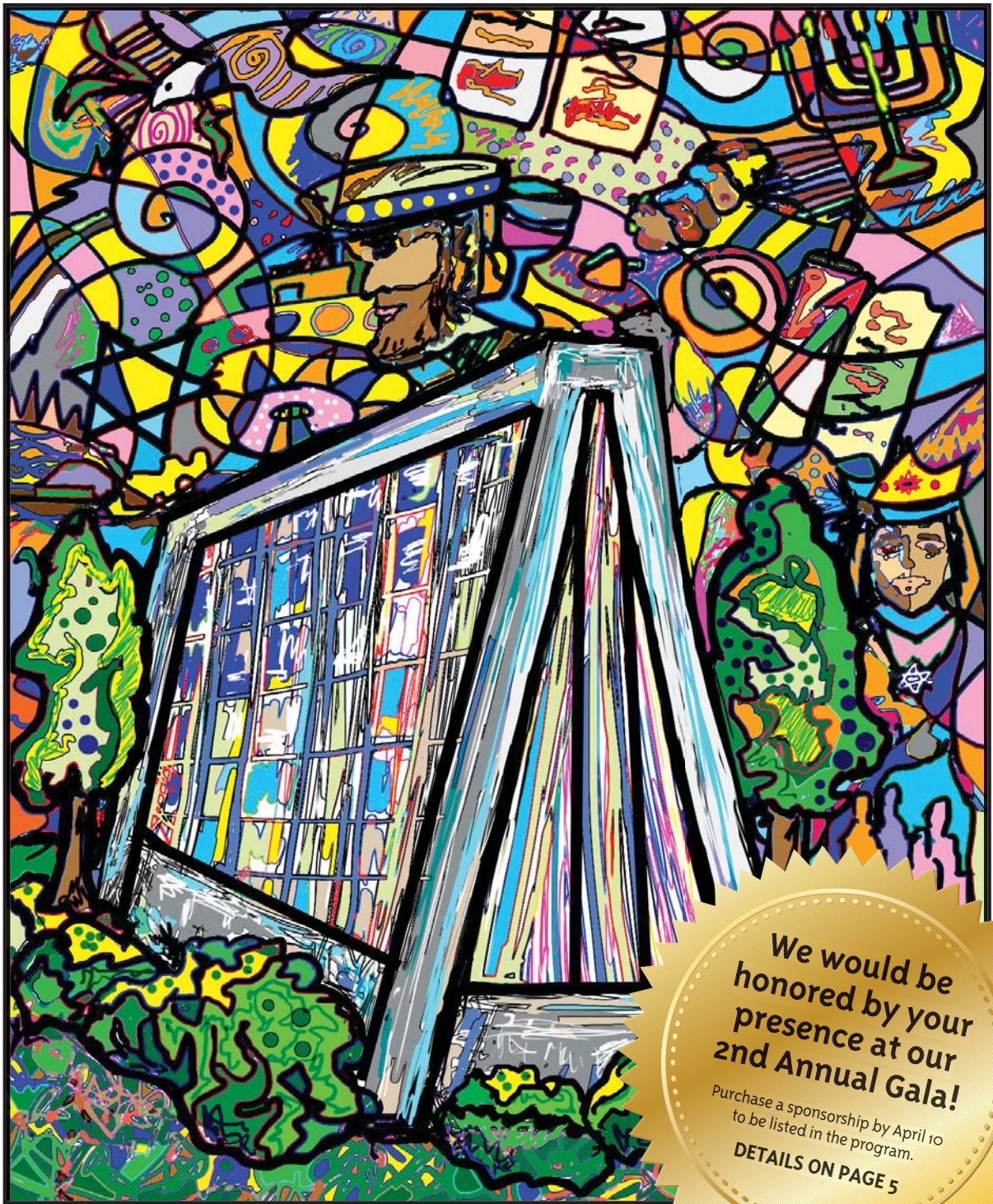

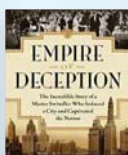

Passover

Growing up in a conservative Jewish household, we always celebrated two nights of Passover with family; the first night was at my Aunt Sharon and Uncle Ernie's house and the second night belonged to my Aunt Jody and Uncle Rich. On the first night, the cousins who attended Hebrew Day School practiced "Chad Gadya" in anticipation of the competition to occur on the second night; fast and accurate was the way to win! Pumpkin soup and Uncle Ernie's stories of growing up in Venezuela also awaited us. At Jody and Rich's house, we couldn't wait for the first half of the night to be over so we could dive in to the meal-carrot soufflé and strawberry fluff made Passover quite delicious! Uncle Rich always prided himself on his afikoman hiding spots, and then rewarded all the kids with small toys from his pharmacy store-even if we weren't the one who found the middle matzah.

As the years passed, we lost key members of our family (my father, my Zadie, and then Uncle Ernie). The Passover table felt empty. Our designated roles in telling the Passover story changed and whenever I saw my dad's name marked in the Haggadah next to a passage, tears filled my eyes. These adjustments in a long-standing family tradition led me to have mixed feelings about the holiday; while I loved spending time with family, the loss of our loved ones was intensely palpable. It is for this reason that I was extremely excited to be in Israel in 2012 for Passover - I couldn't wait to see how my Israeli family celebrated this wonderful holiday. While we enjoyed each other's company, as well as the view of the Sea of Galilee from my cousin's home, something felt missing.

In 2014 I was back in town for Passover. I brought my then boyfriend, Brad, with me to my aunt and uncle's new house (which they bought specifically because they could fit 50 people in one room for Passover)...it was everything I had remembered: laughter, tears, and memories of the past. Yet there was something new there as well- a promise for the future. Looking around the room, seeing my young cousins read Hebrew, I was incredibly thankful for the gift of family.

On April 10, TBE will celebrate the second night of Passover at our Annual Family Seder. We hope you will join us for this warm and welcoming evening as we commemorate the liberation of our people from Egypt with our TBE family. Chag Sameach to all!

The Hazon Seal of Sustainability provides a roadmap to advance sustainability-related education, action, and advocacy in the Jewish community.

I am proud to report that Temple Beth El has been accepted into the 2017 cohort of the Seal of Sustainability, offered by Hazon. Hazon, which means vision, is an organization that works to create a healthier and more sustainable Jewish community, and through that, a better world for all.

Their motto, "The Torah is a commentary on the world, and the world is a commentary on the Torah," is reflective of their determination "to apply Jewish thought to some of the greatest challenges of our time – and our belief that the act of doing so is good not only for the world, but also for the renewal of Jewish life itself."

This worthy goal is one which we at Temple Beth El share, and our participation in this process will not only make our congregation (and the world) healthier and more sustainable, but will bring Temple Beth El to the forefront of this issue in our community. I have begun forming a Sustainability Task Force to work with me on this project.

We will complete audits to check our current performance on issues like Facilities and Energy or Health and Healthy Ecosystems, which will highlight areas of desired improvement and give us ideas and inspiration. We will then designate three projects on which we would like to focus this year. We will have ongoing staff support from Hazon, as well as cohort training webinars, to help us achieve our goals.
