TEMPLE BETH EL HOSTED a sold out event for 320 TBE members and friends on Saturday, November 7, a Gala that featured live entertainment, food, and enduring friendships. Kim Raznik said, "TBE165 co-chairs Traci Feldman, Melissa Schiller and Anne Weiner created a chic and unforgettable evening featuring comedian Dave Coulier, a Michigan native, host of America's Funniest People and TV personality 'Joey' from Full House." Kim added, "The Gala was designed to celebrate 165 years of TBE history and build excitement about our community's future."

The Day Jessica Visited the Braille Bindery

THE TEMPLE BETH EL'S SISTERHOOD BRAILLE BINDERY was alive with excitement that Tuesday morning when Jessica Lemond, then age 10, aided by her cane, entered the doorway. She was accompanied by her grandmother, Joyce Lemond, and her older brother, Dillon.



For several years, Jessica had eagerly received books on a weekly basis printed at the Bindery. She not only came to visit, but to join the volunteers in typing labels in Braille and placing them on book covers. Jessica also toured the Temple, stopping outside the Helen DeRoy Sanctuary where The Man Blowing A Shofar carved by Temple member Nedra Kapetansky was then located. She reached up, feeling the head, face and ram's horn of the wooden sculpture with her fingertips. Jessica has been blind since birth.

Visitors are always welcome each Tuesday morning in the Braille Bindery to observe the volunteers busy at work transcribing, embossing (printing), binding, labeling, and shipping books for children living anywhere in the United States or abroad. The volunteers include Sandy Marks, Chair; Irv Baron, Rita Gray, Barbara Mandelbaum, Janet Mazzara, Earl Remer, Bob Sovel, and Audrey Saperstein. Over 1,300 different reading books are available for blind or low-vision children. The Temple Beth El's Sisterhood Braille Bindery provides these books free of charge, although a donation to help maintain equipment and pay for supplies such as paper is always welcome.

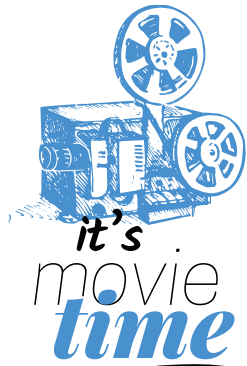

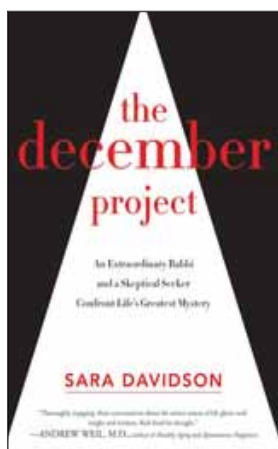

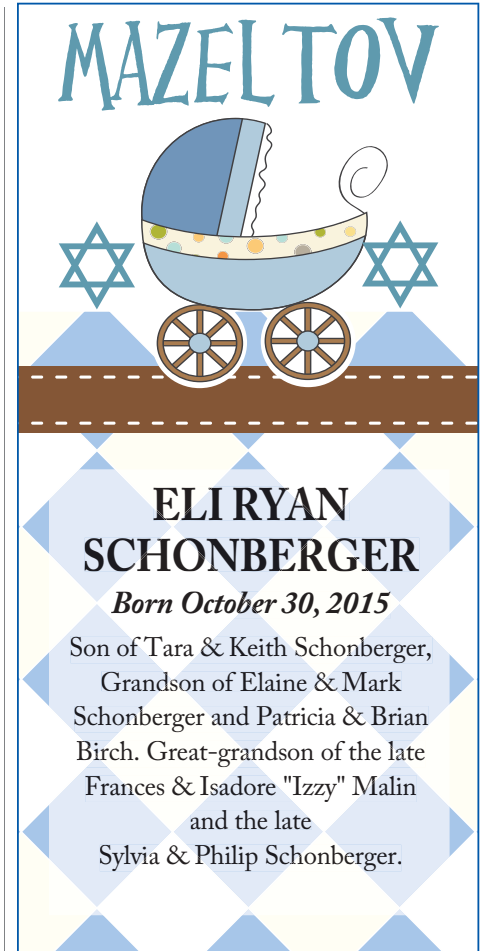
