FLINT PEN PALS

5th graders in Justin Wedes' class have been

Flint. Exchanging letters has taught students

making me laugh and I'll make you laugh."*

Justin Wedes, TBE Member, Testifies About Flint Water Before the UN Commission



In February Justin Wedes, TBE member and community activist, traveled to New York City to testify about water in Flint and Detroit before the United Nations' Commission for Social Development at its Civil Society Forum. Afterward, he and a fellow activist sent a letter to the U.S. Mission to the United Nations asking for the United Nations to send a fact-finding mission to Flint. ***"Our message to the United Nations is that we don't have confidence in our government to properly remedy the Flint and Detroit water crisis,"*** said Justin Wedes, in a recent article published in the Detroit Free Press. ***"They've shown themselves unwilling and unable to take action urgently to ensure the human right of water for all."*** Justin is hoping to pressure the U.S. Mission, staffed by the U.S. State Department, to invite UN Special Rapporteur Baskut Tuncak to Flint to investigate human rights violations and the mismanagement of hazardous materials. Beth El is proud of Justin for his pursuit of justice for the people of Detroit & Flint that do not have access to clean water.

DR. HENRY POLLOCK

Emeritus Professor of geophysics at the University of Michigan and a member of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) receiving the 2007 Nobel Peace Prize.

HENRY POLLACK and his colleagues on the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change shared the 2007 Nobel Peace Prize with former Vice President Al Gore. Dr. Pollack has been a professor of geophysics at the University of Michigan for more than forty years, travels regularly to Antarctica, and has conducted scientific research on all seven continents. He now serves as a science adviser to Al Gore's Climate Project. He is the author of *Uncertain Science... Uncertain World and A World without Ice*.


