Praying for the peace of Jerusalem

UNITY

RABBI MARK MILLER

One of my favorite maxims from the Talmud is, *Kol Yisrael aravim zeh ba zeh ... “All of Israel is responsible for one another.”* (Shavuot 39a)

Although it sounds simple, this teaching reflects a powerful ideal in a less than perfect world. It is easy to say that we should all care about one another, support one another, embrace one another. After all, as a tiny minority (Jews make up approximately 2% of the US population, and a miniscule 0.2% of the world population) it makes sense for our community to be unified in order to both protect and express ourselves.

Except that within our little community lies a vast array of different perspectives, practices, cultures, languages, beliefs, and more. Whether you look at it as a blessing or a curse, the reality of the Jewish people is that millennia of wandering the globe, seeking a safe place or a better future, has left us as diverse as a single people could possibly be.

Which makes it all the more disconcerting when other people – particular those who don’t like us – lump us all together: “The Jews.” Although some don’t see or appreciate our differences, it is precisely the distinctness within our Jewish community that makes the Talmud’s call for collective responsibility so challenging.

I can sing “Am Yisrael Chai” (the Jewish People lives) all day long, but it’s not so easy to call an ultraorthodox rabbi wearing 17th century Polish clothing and claiming that homosexuality causes earthquakes my brother.

It’s not so simple to see myself reflected in a Jewish woman living in Ghana or Uganda, singing a tribal form of Hebrew and observing either creative or pre-modern Jewish rituals. I’m obviously not judging the seemingly limitless expressions of Judaism around the globe – but noting that our practical differences can feel almost as important as all the traditions and beliefs that tie us together.

Our shared roots in the land of Israel is one of the defining features for Jewish communities everywhere. No matter how far we’ve spread out or how different we look or sound or behave ... every Jewish person and every Jewish practice ultimately emerged from our ancient homeland in Israel. Israel is the source of our peoplehood, our culture, our belief system, our way of life. And while the last several months have been agonizing after the brutality of October 7, I am also heartened by the outpouring of concern and love and yes, shared responsibility, that has grown since then.

Right here at Temple Beth El, of course, we have been extremely involved in supporting Jews at home and in Israel and everywhere in between. We have sponsored programs, sent donations, advocated in public, shared sermons and teachings, written letters to soldiers during a Temple Shabbat dinner, and created cards at our big Chanukah celebration. My hope is that, not only will we continue to share the responsibility for our wider Jewish world, but that we will find that support returning to us in ways that we may not be able to envision, but which will make our own TBE community stronger and more vibrant.

TBE Sisterhood's Collective Impact in Community Service

In the rich fabric of community service, the threads of sisterhood intricately weave a story of compassion, collaboration, and profound community impact. As a founding member of Corner Shower and Laundry, Sue Goldsmith's journey unfolds amidst the transformative power of TBE Sisterhood.

Corner Shower and Laundry emerged from a shared moment of empathy during Mitzvah Day/Christmas Day in 2013. Partnering with St Peter's Church, Sue and her family and I encountered a rusty, dilapidated shower in a nearby space, sparking the vision for a project that would ultimately become a sanctuary for those in need. Sisterhood stood by her side, supporting this vision from its infancy.

Through years of research, fundraising, and renovating a church basement, they officially opened the doors in February 2020, offering four private shower stalls, three sink stations, two lavatories, and three sets of washing machines and dryers – all devoted to providing a fresh start for the community.

TBE Sisterhood's unwavering support has been pivotal in their success, embodying the true spirit of working together as a community. The recent "6th Annual Cookie Walk" fundraiser stands as a testament to this collective strength. With 20 onsite volunteers, predominantly Sisterhood members, and 52 volunteer bakers, many from Sisterhood, the event showcased over **60 varieties of cookies**. The results were heartening – over 60 guests served on-site, 13 online orders delivered, and an impressive **250 pounds of cookies sold, raising over \$5000**. This support helps sustain Corner Shower and Laundry and radiates joy and anticipation among our guests yearly.

Beyond this cause, TBE Sisterhood extends its reach and support to other vital community programs. Recently, members volunteered for Bookstock, meticulously organizing donated books by genre, contributing to the upcoming Bookstock sale in April. The efficiency and dedication displayed during this event earned commendations from the Bookstock staff.

At the core of these shared initiatives lies the strength of TBE Sisterhood—a group of women with a collective passion for *tikkun olam*. The Cookie Walk and Bookstock initiatives are part of the **many** ways they transform individual passions into an interconnected movement for positive change.

that Black people just deal with pain. It's impossible," he said. "When you hear gospel, when you hear jazz, when you hear all these things, that's turning pain into power."

We as Jews have much experience with turning pain into power. When we were excluded from clubs and schools, we started our own, and made them the best there were. When we were only allowed to hold certain jobs, we raised the level of those careers, so that they became high-powered and well-paying. From the near genocide of our people, we created a Jewish state in our ancient homeland. The circumstances there, barren desert on a tiny piece of land, with enemies all around, led to a gritty determination to make the desert bloom and to have the strongest military possible, with innovation baked into the very pita (and hummus) that we ate.

Many of you know that my daughter ilana and I were in the William Gibson play *The Miracle Worker*, based on the early life of Helen Keller. Helen famously said, "Optimism is the faith that leads to achievement; nothing can be done without hope and confidence." Keller's life itself is a testament to optimism and achievement under difficult circumstances. She wrote the following letter to the New York Symphony Orchestra in March 1924. Here's how she describes listening to Beethoven's "Ninth Symphony" over the radio:

"Dear Friends: I have the joy of being able to tell you that, though deaf and blind, I spent a glorious hour last night listening over the radio to Beethoven's "Ninth Symphony." I do not mean to say that I "heard" the music in the sense that other people heard it; and I do not know whether I can make you understand how it was possible for me to derive pleasure from the symphony. It was a great surprise to myself.

I had been reading in my magazine for the blind of the happiness that the radio was bringing to the sightless everywhere. I was delighted to know that the blind had gained a new source of enjoyment; but I did not dream that I could have any part in their joy.

Last night, when the family was listening to your wonderful rendering of the immortal symphony someone suggested that I put my hand on the receiver and see if I could get any of the vibrations.

He unscrewed the cap, and I lightly touched the sensitive diaphragm. What was my amazement to discover that I could feel, not only the vibration, but also the impassioned rhythm, the throb and the urge of the music!

As I listened, with darkness and melody, shadow and sound filling all the room, I could not help remembering that the great composer who poured forth such a flood of sweetness into the world was deaf like myself. I marveled at the power of his quenchless spirit by which out of his pain he wrought such joy for others – and there I sat, feeling with my hand the magnificent symphony which broke like a sea upon the silent shores of his soul and mine."

May each of us, saddled with our own difficulties and blindnesses, allow ourselves to experience joy and silliness even amidst a difficult moment in our history. May we find power in our pain, and something akin to the ecstatic poignancy in music unheard by the ear, yet experienced by the soul.

Amen.

POWER IN Pain

With Purim approaching, some are asking whether it is appropriate to be joyful and silly with so much pain in the world.

Our Purim Spiel this year, both for the youth choir's spiel at the Megillah reading on March 17th and for the adult purim party on Thursday, March 21st, is Esther's Story (Taylor's Version). For those who know Taylor Swift's music, and certainly for those who consider themselves "Swifties," the joke inherent in the title is immediately clear. Since she did not own the masters of her earlier albums, she has rerecorded and rereleased them with the name of the original album, followed by "(Taylor's Version)." But this title also carries baggage with it. Taylor Swift, one of the greatest stars of her generation, had lost power over her own music. However, instead of succumbing to the powerlessness, she created new versions of her songs, taking back the power, using her pain to create joy.

Similarly, in the new movie *The Color Purple*, which I saw on Christmas Day (before eating Chinese food, of course), the details of Celie's life (and others in the story as well) are so painful, that one would think the result would be a depressing movie. Yet the glorious joy experienced by the end of it was moving indeed. In an article in *The New York Times*, author Tiffany Martinbrough tells us that director Blitz Bazawule's intention was "to oscillate between joy and pain, a very human approach." He said, "We never wallow in just pain. Certainly, a people who have birthed such beautiful manifestations to this world, there's no way

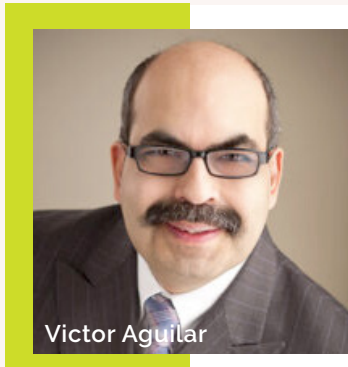
Damon Kaigler

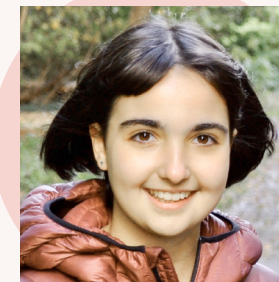
